Method of use:

Surface preparation:

Comtech Top EP10 should not be applied to concrete which contains more than 5% moisture. The removal of laitance and contaminants is best achieved by mechanical means.

The surface to be sound clean and uncontaminated.

Priming:

Prime using Comtech Prime EP20, Mix the two components using a slow speed drill with a suitable paddle. Mix until uniform consistency is obtained.



Mixing:

Comtech Screed EP50 should be mixed mechanically.

Mix Part A and Part B separately for a minute.

Then mix Part A and Part B thoroughly for 1 minutes till a uniform and homogenous consistency is achieved.

Then add Part C and mix slowly the whole three components for 2 minutes. systems are supplied in

Comtech Screed EP50 is preweighed packs which should not be split or divided. It is important to use complete packs.

Application:

Comtech Screed EP50 should be applied while the primer coat of Comtech Prime EP20 is still wet.

If the primer coat had come dry re-prime again.

Apply a full mixed set on the wet primer at a thickness of 3-5mm.

Packaging and storage:

Comtech Screed EP50 is supplied in 44.5Kg set, All Comtech products should be stored in a dry shaded area, protected from breakage, deterioration and contamination.

Health and safety:

Comtech Screed EP50 does not classified in the hazardous materials; however it should not be allowed to come into prolonged contact with skin and eyes.

The normal safety precautions (hand gloves & safety goggles) are recommended for handling.

The first aid if some harm happened with eyes in to wash with water.
